Through the watercolour medium Sarah attempts to create light and fun pieces that resonate with her audience on several levels. Largely self-taught, Sarah has been developing her painting skills over the past year which has helped to bring extra layers of depth and detail into her most recent work. I like to focus on fine details and to add intricate brush work to each of my paintings to magnify elements of objects and everyday things that may otherwise seem ordinary and simple. Sometimes it's the little things in life.

These six botanical inspired pieces are framed and mounted in a custom 'floating' box frame made from conservation grade materials. Each frame is crafted from solid Tasmanian oak, then hand sanded and finished with a coating of natural beeswax. The individual paintings are then mounted against archival grade acid-free backings, with gallery grade acrylic facings (99% UV block).


