Background

Southern Tablelands Arts is the peak arts and cultural organisation within the Southern Tablelands region of NSW. The organisation has been in operation since 1997. Core funding is provided by Create NSW and seven local government areas: Wollondilly, Wingecarribee Shire, Goulburn Mulwaree, Upper Lachlan, Yass Valley, Hilltops Councils and Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council.

Southern Tablelands Arts facilitates the development of arts and cultural projects and initiatives across the STA region, contributing to a rich cultural landscape and increasing participation in arts and cultural activities. It plays a vital role in building cultural community capacity through advice and advocacy, capacity building and with the forging of key partnerships and networks throughout the region.

The successful candidate will be an energetic and enthusiastic arts professional with administration skills. The GA is a mature, reliable individual, who can work unsupervised, with excellent interpersonal skills, time management skills and a passion for the arts.

Key Responsibilities:

- Open *Connect@Gunning* Station when exhibitions are held.
- Attend the gallery spaces, and ensure the gallery is set up as per exhibition instructions.
- Greet and communicate with general public, artists, and gallery visitors.
- Supervise the exhibition spaces during the day as visitors attend.
- Guide people through Connect@Gunning Station and assist where needed in wayfinding throughout the Station.
- Follow the Rules of Use for **Connect@Gunning** Station and explain these Rules to visitors as required to encourage compliance with the rules and safe behaviors at the Station.
- Manage sales of exhibition.
- Maintain the physical presentation of the gallery space.
- Support the curatorial process and installation of exhibitions.
- Assist at Connect@Gunning events, exhibition openings and evening/weekend exhibitions.
- Safely and securely close at closing time.
- Administrative duties.
- General assistance as required.
